HOW WE LEARN

Here at Jigsaw, we use several different strategies to learn through play including:

Child Led Play – Children are encouraged to take their own lead during play, following their own interests with the adult providing support where necessary. This type of learning is the most predominate at jigsaw.

Adult Led Play - This allows the practitioners in the setting to lead play/activities focused on a theme or target that is relevant to current interests or needs.

Big Build – Big Build is a large-scale construction project that involves all the children in the setting and touches on all areas of the EYFS. Recent projects have included 'Volcano Island' home corner inspired by the recent eruptions in Iceland and our Scarecrows for the Burscough Scarecrow festival which we
