## Suicide Bereavement: Practical Applications Conference 2024

Throughout September 2024, Harmless is hosting its fifth annual online Suicide Bereavement Conference. To mark World Suicide Prevention Day, we will be presenting a series of live webinars examining practical applications for working in suicide bereavement. Sessions take place every Tuesday and Thursday between 10am – 11am and each will be led by an expert in the field. Our theme this year is *Stopping the Ripples, Turning the Tide: The Role of Suicide Bereavement Interventions in Saving Lives*.

Suicide bereavement is a particularly specialist area. So many of us have been impacted by suicide – the tragic loss of a loved one, a colleague, someone in our community, a patient, or someone very supportive... everyone has a story to tell.

This conference is designed to help those of us working with anyone impacted by suicide. Delegates can expect to take away a range of knowledge, inspiration and skills for practical implementation in real-life situations. Learning from leaders in the field, delegates will experience interactive sessions that can help to drive change.

This unique CPD-accredited event will take place across eight short webinars, allowing you the flexibility to join as many as you like.
