Your rights under the Data Protection Act

Each individual has certain rights under the Act and Community Futures must abide by these rights.



They are:

- The right to subject access; this means that you have the right to see what personal information the charity holds about you.
- The right to prevent processing; if you feel it can cause damage or distress you can ask Community Futures to stop processing the information.
- The right to prevent processing for direct marketing.
- Rights to stop decisions being made only by automatic means; this refers to an automated decision that has been taken about you automatically.
- You have a right to compensation if any damage or distress is caused to you because Community Futures has breached the Act.
- You have the right to apply to the court to ask the charity to rectify, block, destroy or erase any personal details that are inaccurate.
- You have the right to ask the Information Commissioner to assess if Community Futures has contravened the Act.
